Depending on your personal circumstances, you may be eligible to receive a full or partial fee reduction on some of our courses. Look out for the symbols below next to our courses throughout the guide and refer to this page to confirm your eligibility.

C Course fees support

If your household income is below £45,000 per annum, you will likely be entitled to our financial support scheme which will provide contribution towards course fees. This contribution differs between courses and you will be provided with more information once you have completed your application. A contribution towards course fees is only available if you (or your course) are not eligible for one of the other full waivers.

Level entitlement

If you are aged 19-23 and you do not already a have a full level 2 gualification (or a level 3 qualification, if your chosen course is at level 3) or higher, your course will be fully funded.

U Unemployment or low income

If you are unemployed and claiming an income-based state benefit, your course will be fully funded. Alternatively, if you are employed and your income is below £20,319 per annum, your course will be fully funded.

Level 3 Courses for Jobs

Your course will be fully funded if you are yet to complete a level 3 (or higher) qualification or you are unemployed (and claiming a state benefit) or employed on a low income (less than £20,319 per annum).





ENGLISH AND MATHS

GCSEs are an important stepping-stone to get a job, change career or continue studying. Many employers, colleges and universities will ask for a minimum of five GCSEs, including English and Maths.

Our English and Maths courses are free for those who do not have a grade 4 (C) or above in their chosen subject. For example, if you want to study Maths and you have a grade 3, the course will be free.

If you are aged 19 or over when you start your course and your household income is below £45,000 per annum (yours and your co-habiting partner's if applicable), you are likely to be eligible for either our Discretionary Learner Support Fund or Advanced Learner Loan Bursary.

If eligible, you could receive a contribution towards:

- courses fees, if applicable
- transport a contribution is allocated based on mileage and is paid at the end of each month (based on your attendance)
- uniform, kit and equipment
- compulsory trips
- accommodation if you are studying Access to Medicine or Access to Veterinary Science and live over 2.5 hours away and relocate to the area
- childcare costs for the hours you are in college (for those aged 20 or above. If you are 19, please see gov.uk/care-to-learn).

Please note that learners who pay the full course fee for a Level 3 or Level 4 course are not eligible for either bursary.
